Registration:

1. Complete a [credit registration form](#) from MSUM Continuing Studies.
2. Register with PBS TeacherLine. Once you have registered with Continuing Studies you will be emailed the information to register with TeacherLine.

Two days before the course start date, the link for the course will become active, at which time learners can click the hyperlinked course title to access the course. This two-day window can be used to explore and become familiar with the course. Notice that you must complete both steps to take this credit course. Register early to insure you have this exploration time.
